

- 9) If you choose a course from the approved list, no additional approval is required. Do not use the CEAS Transfer Credit Review Form. If you're looking for a specific course or school that isn't listed, follow the instructions in our other guide, "Transferology Instructions – How to see if a course is pre approved."

Important! Even if a course is approved to transfer and to count toward your degree, you should be aware of the following:

You must get a C or higher for CU Boulder to accept the course for transfer. Your department may require a C or higher for the course to count toward your degree.

You are responsible for making up any difference in semester credit hours between the CU Boulder course and the transfer course. Be especially cautious when taking a class on a quarter system, as these will be converted to semester hours when the class is transferred.

You must petition to waive the In Residence Credit Requirement if you will be within 45 credits of graduation when you take the transfer course.
