The Dean of the College of Music has made funds available to graduate students in music to support their research, scholarship, and creative work. The Dean's Graduate Music Student Grant are intended to support graduate students' expenses related to **off-campus performances and conference presentations/papers, degree-related projects, and attendance in an official capacity at conferences or workshops.**

Any full-time graduate music student in good standing who is making adequate progress toward a



6. **Unofficial transcript.** A copy of a more recent unofficial transcript should include the current semester registration. To accept a transcript, log in to Blackboard. On the unofficial transcript card, elect the unofficial transcript.

Types of projects **not considered** for funding (in priority order) by the Dean Graduate Student Grant are:

- ! Student presenting off-campus paper and performance. Student who has advanced past the initial round of a performance competition or who has had a paper accepted for presentation will be given priority. Importance of the event is also a consideration.
- ! Assistance in purchase or rental of material or other expense essential for **degree-related** Project (e.g. dissertation research expense; DMA recording project expense).
- ! Funding for the dissertation project research and essential expense (e.g., archival fees, special technical/graphic design, composition commission, dissertation data collection and/or analysis expense)
- ! Attendance, in some official capacity, at a conference or workshop.

Normally, projects **not considered** for funding include expense associated with a dissertation or the initial stage of a performance competition. Also, funding will not be awarded to a student who performs a dissertation or for dissertation project.
